Dear Eastbrook Family,

Eastbrook Academy was recognized by the Department of Public Instruction (DPI) as one of the top-performing schools in Wisconsin. DPI produces an annual Accountability Report Card to help parents and students compare school performance across the state using standard criteria in the areas of Student Achievement, Student Growth, Closing Gaps, and Post-Secondary Readiness.

Eastbrook Academy received DPI's highest Overall Accountability Rating with a score of 87.8 out of 100 for all students. While 1,536 schools "Meets Expectations" or "Exceeds Expectations," only 13% of all public and private schools in the state reach the designation of "Significantly Exceeds Expectations." Eastbrook Academy stands out as the only school to receive this rating while providing instruction to all three levels: Elementary, Middle, and High School.

"This is a direct result of the strong relationships between our students, teachers, and faculty," said Michael Maxson, Head of School at Eastbrook Academy. "We offer small class sizes, which allows our teachers to provide individual attention and care to each student. Although it was not a requirement by the state, we test 100% of our student population. We are pleased to see that all of our students are reaching high levels of academic growth and achievement. Also, we are excited that our efforts are having an impact on closing achievement gaps for our diverse student body."
